The Texas Food & Fuel Association (TFFA) Scholarship Foundation will award four scholarships to exemplary high school seniors graduating from accredited high schools within the state of Texas.

MEMBERSHIP AFFILIATION ELIGIBILITY

- **Two (2) Four-year scholarships** (\$12,000 award, 1,500 per semester).
Awarded to dependent children of marketer or retailer members (including employee's children)
- **One (1) Four-year scholarship** (\$12,000 award, \$1,500 per semester).
Awarded to dependent children of supplier members (including employee's children).
- **One (1) Two-year Trade/Tech school scholarship** (\$6,000 award, \$1,500 per semester).
Awarded to dependent children of supplier members (including employee's children).

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must:

- Be a U.S. Citizen and Texas Resident
- Be a graduating high school senior or graduate of an accredited public/private high school
- Be under age 21
- A high school senior who is:
 - A dependent child of TFFA, or
 - Actively employed by a marketer, retailer or supplier member of TFFA
- Plan to attend an accredited college, university, or trade-tech school
- Demonstrate academic achievement, leadership, character, and economic need
- Include a recommendation from a high school (education) administrator

REQUIRED MATERIALS

- Narrative (maximum two pages, 8 ½" x 11")
- Recent headshot photo (high-resolution if submitted by email)
- Official transcript, including class size and rank
- Proof of passing required Texas exams
- College/University enrollment plans
- Proof of citizenship
- List any awards received in high school, extracurricular activities, or previous work history

SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION OF RECIPIENTS

Applications are reviewed by an independent committee using a rating sheet based on eligibility criteria. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Scholarship recipients will be notified individually after the spring semester. The Foundation will also notify the central administrative office of each participating school district.
